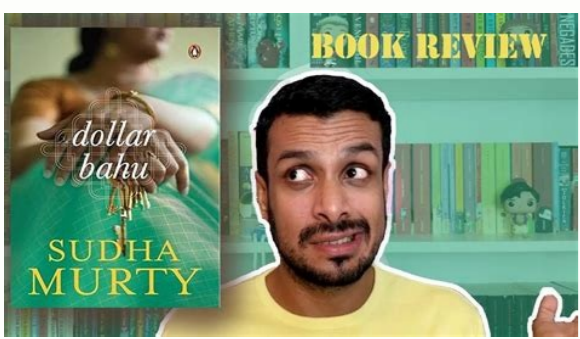

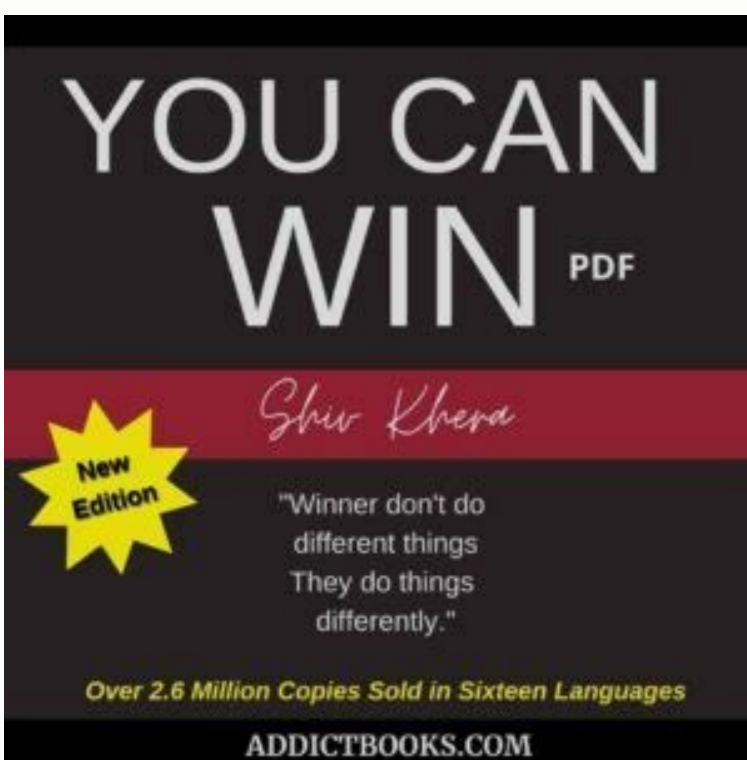
The Context
